

In the event of an exposure to infectious tuberculosis, we recommend testing for anyone at risk. Two tests are offered, the quantiferon gold (QFT) blood test and the skin test. Both tests are good indicators of tuberculosis infection.

How the testing works:

- This is an optional program—your child is not required to participate.
 - If you do not wish for your child to participate, please <u>DO NOT</u> fill out this consent form.
- There is **no-cost** to your family; you will **not** be billed for a copay.
- The Tuberculosis Clinic will follow up with anyone who has a positive test for next steps. Treatment and follow up is available at no cost through the Tuberculosis Clinic.
